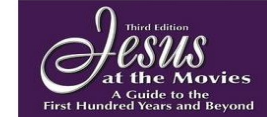
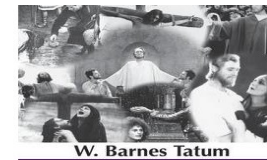

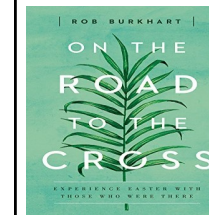

Ash Wednesday Service

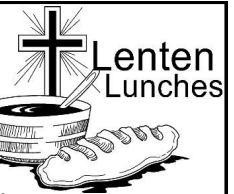
