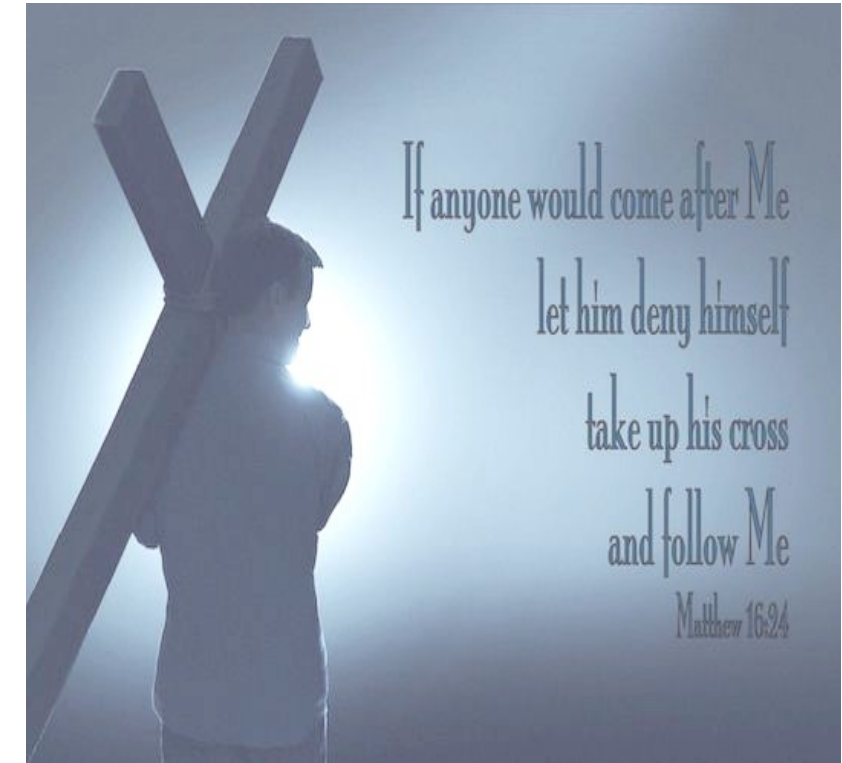

## Jesus at the Movies

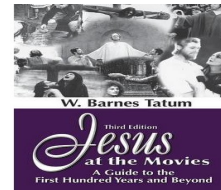
