Girls- Size 4-10 underwear, socks size 4 & 10.

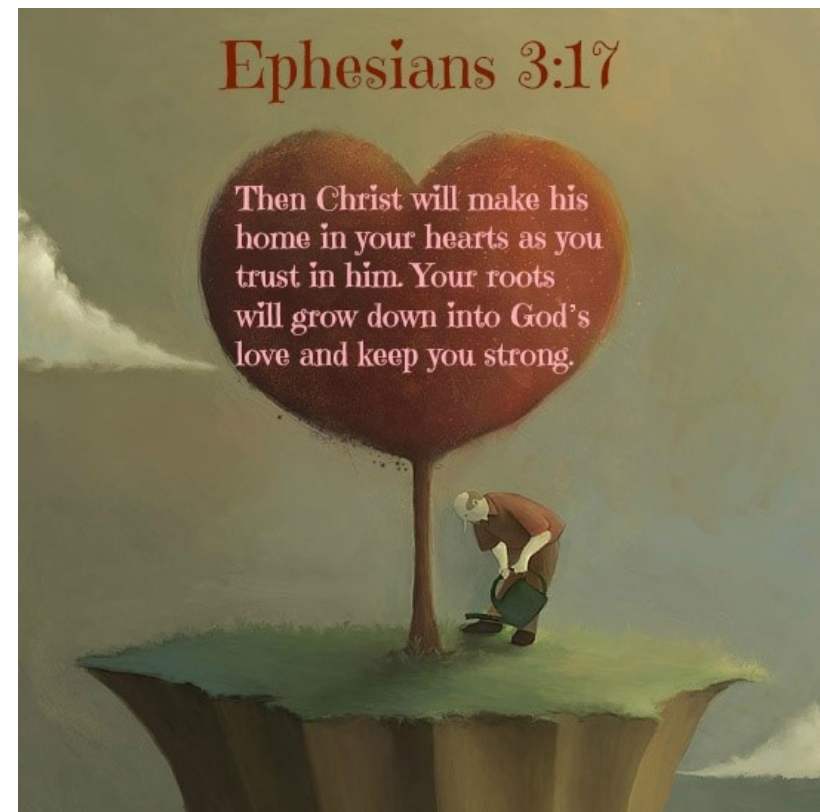
Not sizes 6-8 for girls, they have plenty.
