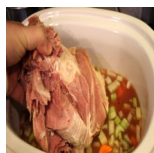
## Cancellations

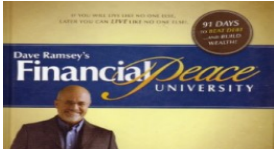
