

PERSONAL DIGNITY KITS
(formerly health/hygiene kits)
FOR THE INGATHERING

Most of you know that each October we have a Sunday where you can pay for a hygiene kit and put all the items together after worship. Covid-19 has caused us to take another route for this year.

The kits this year will go to Midwest Mission Distribution Center in Chatham, IL. Their kits are called personal dignity kits (hereafter listed as PDKs.) They require four more items than the previous kits. So, **the cost this year will be \$8**, rather than \$6. That price pays for the shipping and all the items for each kit.

Here is a way you can participate and stay safe.

1) Call (563-732-2095) or email (tczhis@netwtc.net) Connie Zeleny to **order how many kits you would like** to pay for and take home **to put together**. All **orders** need to be received **by September 30**.

2) Tom and Connie will put all the needed items for each person's order in a clean bag, along with complete instructions on how to put the kits together. There's even a link to a video that shows how to assemble the kits.

3) During the **week of October 11th**, you can pick up your order from the Zeleny home at 407 E. Prairie Street in Wilton. Make out your **check to the church**, indicating PDKs on the memo line and **give to Connie when you pick up your kits to compile**.

4) Finished kits need to be **returned** to big tubs outside the north church door **by October 18th**. There will be a clipboard there with your name, the number of kits you ordered and put together. Check off your kits when you return the completed PDKs to the tubs.
