It's that time of year when we start working on kits for the 47th Mission Ingathering on November 7. This year's kits will all be donated to Midwest Mission Distribution Center in Chatham, IL, which you can learn about at <http://www.midwestmission.org/>.

A list of the items needed for school kits is included in this newsletter. There are also other helpful kits listed in brochures that are on the Ingathering table in Fellowship Hall. Clothe bags are also on that table for you to use. We will be putting PDKs (Health Kits) together as a congregation in October.

If you prefer to donate money towards the Ingathering kits, that is fine, too. Just be sure, Ingathering Donation is listed on your check memo line. As always, your prayers are a great donation, too. All kits are due by November 1st. Leave completed kits on the table at the back of fellowship hall. Sign the clipboard list on that table. Contact Connie Fratzke with questions, 563-529-1251.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

*** \$3 shipping per kit – no cash or checks in bag.

* Sign your first name only on the prayer card and offer a prayer for the student who will be blessed to receive your kit. * NO MONEY or checks in the bags.

Make your check to our church for the \$3 shipping per kit, listing Ingathering shipping on the memo line, and drop it in the offering plate.

* Place ALL items in the cloth bag. Include ONLY the items listed.

School Kits:

(3) Notebooks – 1 subject spiral, 8"x 10 ½"

(1) Ruler – 12" long with metric

(6) Pencils – unsharpened "Plain yellow pencils please No camouflage"!

(1) Pencil sharpener

(1) Eraser – 2" or larger

(1) Box of 12 colored pencils

(1) Box of 24 crayons

(1) Pair – student scissors

(1) One-handled cloth bag

(1) Signed prayer card

* Place ALL items in the cloth bag. Include ONLY the items listed.

* **NO cash or checks in the bag.**

If you can't provide a complete kit, Remember also that while complete kits are excellent, individual items are truly valuable. Those pieces can be put with others to make a complete kit at Midwest Mission.

Serving Together: Missions at Home!

A lot goes into the operations of our church to help keep our finances, buildings, and missions in good shape as we work together in serving God. We have several committees that serve the different needs of the church. The members serve 3-year terms for the primary committees: SPPRC, Trustees, Finance, Nominations, and Administrative Council.

We are working towards getting back into the member rotation on these committees. Some of the primary committees will have some openings coming up later this year, and we are working on getting a couple of other committees started back up.

* **Nominations committee** – helps fit church members and their skills with church committees that have openings coming up. By church law, the pastor serves as the chairperson, and a layperson serves as the vice-chair. Ideally, members serve a staggered 3-year term, but this may take us a few years to accomplish with this starting back up.

* **Hospitality committee** – Simply put, hospitality is how we show love to others in Christ's name – helping with greeters, fellowship time, and checking on those who are home bound.

***Administrative Council** – mostly served by the chairpersons of the primary committees, as well as chairpersons from our more active groups. Administrative council is responsible for financial health, envisioning, planning, implementing, and evaluating the church's ministries to make disciples of Jesus Christ.
